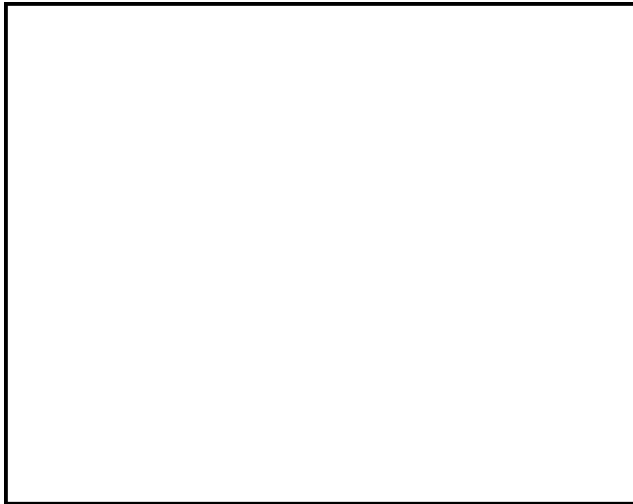


For Us and For Our Salvation

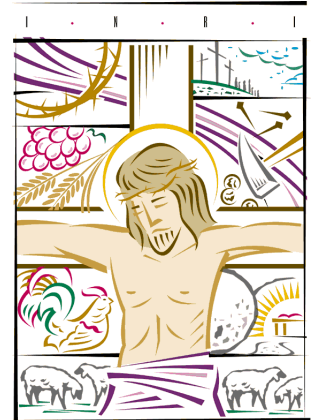
*The Son became human as the man Jesus Christ. Mary was his mother.

The Son became human: Jesus is really a human being like us and really God like the Father. Jesus' mother is named Mary.

Draw a picture of you and your mother. Jesus' mother is named Mary.

Jesus died on the cross: Since Jesus is the Son of God, when he died it meant that death no longer has power over us. Jesus beat death!



Play a game: one friend will pretend to be death and the other friend will pretend to be Jesus. Sit across from each other at the table and arm wrestle. Make sure that the friend pretending to be Jesus wins the arm wrestling match to remind you that Jesus beat death on the cross. Arm wrestle again but switch sides this time and let the other person be Jesus so he can see how it feels to win the game.

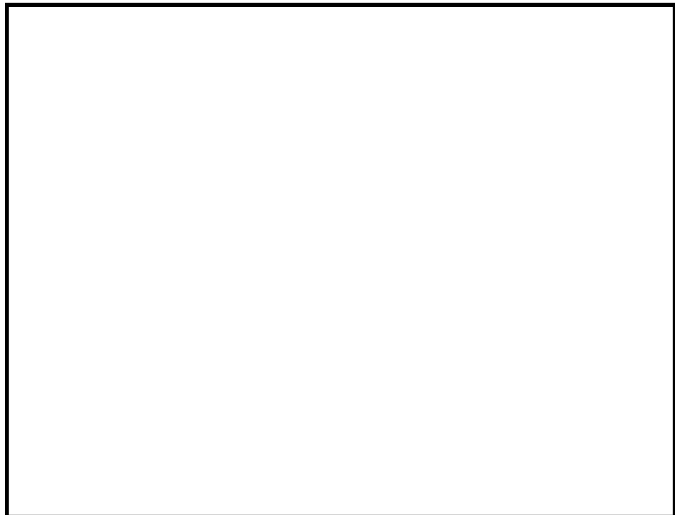

Jesus was resurrected and ascended to heaven: Because Jesus was resurrected and went to be with the Father we also will be resurrected to live with the Father forever.

Play a game: have all your friends stand in a line. The person in the front of the line pretends to be Jesus. He leads everyone in the class around the classroom in a joyful parade. This will help you remember that Jesus took everyone up to heaven in his resurrection and ascension. Take turns pretending to be Jesus.
